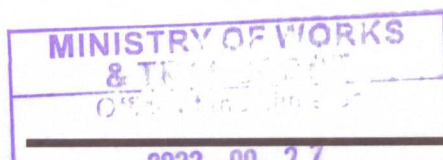

**POSTPONEMENT OF ENTRY INTO FORCE OF GOVERNMENT NOTICE 90 OF 31 MARCH, RELATING TO PART 139: AERODROMES AND GROUND AIDS.**

1. Reference is made to the following documents:
  - (a) My 21 September 2022 letter;
  - (b) NCAA Board Chairperson's 23 September 2022 letter;
  - (c) Namibia Airports Company (NAC) CEO's 20 September 2022 letter;
  - (d) AOPA Acting President's 26 September 2022 letter.
2. The contents of the letters, listed in 1(b), (c) and (d) above, have been duly noted, with a deep sense of empathy.
3. With particular reference to the NCAA Board Chairperson's 23 September 2022 letter, I find the arguments cogent, convincing, sober and practically reasonable.



4. Consequently, I hereby: “postpone entry into force, of Government Notice 90 of 31 March 2022; from 1 October 2022 to 31 March 2023.” Any further postponement, after 31 March 2023, will be very difficult to justify, if not impossible, after all.
5. Hoping that: a legally and practically sound CONSENSUS decision, will be made, sooner, rather than later; within the letter and spirit of the NCAA Board Chairperson’s 23 September 2022 letter’s PARAGRAPHS 5,6,7,8 and 9; please, accept, dear Chairperson, renewed assurances of my most highest consideration, esteem and respect. Please, convey the same to all your Colleagues, the Leaderships of NAC and AOPA, respectively.
