Dear Honorable Mutorwa,

RE: NAC's Organizational Position and Practical Recommendations on New Civil Aviation Regulations as Reported on in a Local German Newspaper

1. We refer to the above matter and a newspaper article pertaining thereto published in the Allgemeine Zeitung newspaper of 19 September 2022.
2. Honorable Minister, kindly take note that the Namibia Airports Company Limited (NAC) forms part of a Civil Aviation Regulations Technical Advisory Panel (CARTAP) Sub-Committee established in accordance with Namibia Civil Aviation Regulations (NAMCARs) Part 11 to review the regulations that form the subject-matter of the newspaper article alluded to above.
3. Other members of CARTAP are the Namibia Civil Aviation Authority (NCAA), Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association (AOPA), University of Namibia (UNAM), Ministry of Works and Transport (MWT), Wilderness Air, Gondwana Collection and an Independent Aviation Consultant.
4. Stakeholder consultations are ongoing vis-à-vis the aforesaid NAMCARs, with the latest such industry consultations having taken place last week Thursday, 15 September 2022, under the auspices of NCAA.
5. Honorable Minister, it is our considered organizational position that we continue to liaise with the regulator and other civil aviation industry stakeholders in respect of the aforesaid regulations through tailor-made efficacious platforms such as CARTAP, with a view to meaningfully airing all viewpoints in such setups that are inclusive of all affected and interested sectoral players, regard being had to the inclusive representation of the said platform as outlined above.
6. Our practical recommendation on the next course of action is accordingly that we continue to engage all relevant parties on the underlying matter through well established industry-specific fora for aforesaid purposes, as more fully set out in the preceding synopsis.

7. Honorable Minister, NAC avails itself of the opportunity to renew to the Ministry of Works and Transport assurance of its highest consideration.
